

EMIT Training Course

COURSE OVERVIEW

EMIT is an **EM**issions Inventory **T**ool which can be used to store, manipulate and assess emissions data from a variety of sources. EMIT may be used to investigate the impact on emissions of various emissions reduction strategies; key amongst these are likely to be implementation of traffic management schemes such as low emission zones (LEZ).

The EMIT training course is aimed at anyone wanting to build an emissions inventory, as well as an organisation being involved in review and assessment processes. No prior knowledge is assumed.

COURSE OUTLINE

Two-day course - 09:30 to 16:30 each day

Day One

- Introduction to EMIT
- Structure of an EMIT Database
- Representing different source types in EMIT
- Creating an EMIT database
- Adding sources to an EMIT database
- Calculating emissions
- Exporting source and emissions data from EMIT
- Visualising exported source data in ArcMap

Day Two

- Representing road sources in EMIT
- Emission factor datasets and 'route types'
- Using EMIT for source apportionment
- Using EMIT for traffic management
 - emissions current and future years
 - restrictions on speed and vehicle type
- Further work on exporting data
 - combining source data from multiple sources
 - exporting to a 3D grid source
- Discussion of other applications of EMIT

On completion of the course you will know what an EMIT database looks like. Specifically, you will know the structure of a database and how to create a new database. You will know the key source parameters used and where they are stored. You will know how to import data to EMIT, calculate emissions and export data from EMIT. Methods of calculating emissions from roads are discussed. The use of EMIT for source apportionment studies and for investigating traffic management schemes is illustrated.

You will be able to display an EMIT database graphically.

Courses can be delivered online or in person. The course runs for two days. If you complete the course online, you will have access to the online platform for a third day, giving you an extra day for course consolidation.

The online course is delivered through a combination of audio presentations, hands-on worked examples and live communication with a CERC expert instructor.
